14	providers of behavioral health care, individuals receiving behavioral health services and family members
15	of individuals receiving behavioral health services, and other interested stakeholders to study barriers to
16	cooperation and communication between law enforcement and behavioral health care providers in cases
17	involving individuals in need of mental health evaluation and treatment and make recommendations
18	related to improving communication and cooperation among law enforcement and behavioral health
19	care providers, including communication and cooperation in cases in which an individual is taken into
20	emergency custody or held for temporary detention or involuntary admission for treatment, in order to
21	improve the setern and well being of the public and the individual. The work group shall report its
