10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That § 2.2-5601 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 2.2-5601. Appointment, term, compensation, and expenses of members of Southern States Energy Board.
13	The Commonwealth's representatives to the Southern States Energy Board shall be appointed in
15	compliance with Article II of the compact Southern States Energy Compact as follows: one member of
16	the House of Delegates appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates, one member of the Senate
17	appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules, and one nonlegislative citizen member appointed by the
18	Governor. Legislative members shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office and shall not have
19	the authority to designate an alternate in accordance with Article II of the compact. The gubernatorial
20	appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. If any member appointed is the head of a
21	department or agency of the Commonwealth, he may designate a subordinate officer or employee of his
22	department or agency to serve in his stead as permitted by Article II A- of the compact and in
23	conformity with any applicable bylaws of the Board. All members may be reappointed for successive
24	terms.
25	Legislative members of the Board shall receive such compensation as provided in § 30-19.12 and
26	shall be reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties
27	as provided in §§ 2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825. The costs of compensation and expenses of the legislative
28	members shall be paid from appropriations to the Virginia Commission on Intergovernmental
29	Cooperation for the attendance of conferences. The nonlegislative citizen member of the Board shall
30	receive such compensation and reimbursement for all his reasonable and necessary expenses in the

31 performance of his duties as may be appropriated or made available for such purposes.
