- . Any person other than a licensed dealer who sells, rents, trades, or transfers any firearm to any on other than a licensed dealer is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.
- 3. Any person other than a licensed dealer who buys, rents, trades, or transfers any firearm from person other than a licensed dealer is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.
- . If neither party to a prospective firearm transfer is a licensed dealer, the parties to the saction shall complete the transfer through a licensed dealer.
- D. Notwithstanding subsection A, B, or C, unless otherwise prohibited by state or federal law, any on may transfer a firearm to any other person if:
