2. Patron: Lingamfelter

3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Concealed handgun permits; references to issuance of handgun before July 1, 2008.

5. Summary: Provides that any references to the issuance of a concealed handgun before July 1, 2008, from any order book maintained by a circuit court clerk are exempt from the requirement that such orders be withheld from public disclosure. The bill also directs circuit court clerks to issue replacement permits to permit holders who undergo a lawful name change.

Fiscal Implications: According to the Office of the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court (OES), the provisions of the proposed legislation would require changes to the electronic records management system maintained by the courts.
