3. Committee: General Laws and Technology

4. Title: Board for Contractors; suspension and monetary penalty for certain violations.

5. Summary: This bill provides that the Board for Contractors shall impose a monetary penalty of \$10,000 for each violation of a statute or regulation involving fraudulent or improper or dishonest conduct involving work initiated during a declared state of emergency.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR). Any penalties incurred would be paid into the Literary Fund. The agency is unable to predict the number of violations and penalties that would result from the legislation; therefore any potential impact on revenue to the Literary Fund is indeterminate.
