4. Title: Creation of a Smart Transportation Pilot Zone in VDOT's Northern Virginia or Hampton Roads Construction District

5. Summary: Requires the Secretary of Transportation and the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to establish a smart transportation pilot zone (modeled on the Smart Road owned by VDOT and managed by the Virginia Tech Transportation Institute in Montgomery County) in either the Northern Virginia or the Hampton Roads highway construction district.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to VDOT, this proposal may result in significant costs associated with planning, developing, constructing, operating, managing, and maintaining a new state of the art smart transportation facility. This includes the costs associated with installation of state of the art information and communications technology to collect, store, and manage the large amounts of data facilities of this type produce. These costs, though, cannot be determined at this time.
