**4. Title:** Temporary detention; transfer.

**5. Summary:** Establishes a procedure for transferring custody of a person who is the subject of a temporary detention order from one facility to another facility.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The proposal is not expected to have a fiscal impact on state funding. However, there could be an increase in costs to law enforcement charged with the transport of individuals between facilities and/or a redistribution of costs among localities since the proposal could increase costs on sheriffs' offices located near hospitals as they might be called upon more frequently for transports. This cost will be dependent on any increase in transports between facilities.
