3. Committee: Education

4. Title: A-to-F school grading system; exemption for schools with alternative accreditation plans.

5. Summary: Current law requires each public school in Virginia to receive a grade from a scale of A-F by October 2014. The proposed legislation would make an exception to the grading system by exempting the schools for which the Board of Education has approved an alternative accreditation plan to meet the graduation and completion index benchmark.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill does not change the process by which the Board of Education approves schools for an alternative accreditation plan, nor does it change the process by which the board assigns grades to each public school using the A-to-F grading system. There is no anticipated state fiscal impact resulting from this legislation.
