4. Title: Clerks offices; recordation of certain records and possession of child pornography materials in the course of performing official duties

5. Summary: Provides that the secretary of an organized fire fighting company may designate duties to another individual to include filing documentation with the circuit court. The bill also provides for clerks may possess child pornography materials in the course of their official duties provided such possession is for a bona fide medical, scientific, governmental, law enforcement or judicial purpose.
