**4. Title:** Purchase or transportation of firearm by persons convicted of certain drug offenses.

**5. Summary:** The proposed legislation provides that any person who has been convicted of two misdemeanor offenses for possession of synthetic cannabinoids, marijuana, or controlled substances within a 36-month period is prohibited from purchasing or transporting a firearm. Currently, the prohibition only applies to handguns.
