**3. Committee:** Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources

**4. Title:** Hunting on Sundays.

**5. Summary:** This bill authorizes the Counties of Fairfax, Fauquier, Loudoun, and Prince William to adopt an ordinance that allows the hunting of wild animals on private lands on Sunday.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary, see item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill adds another day to the hunting season's weeks for a segment of the population. According to the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, there are law enforcement officers as well as other agency staff members who currently work on Sundays. The agency expects an increase in dispatch call intake during the first year of implementation. In addition, the department may need to authorize overtime for conservation officers, or hire additional officers, to enforce provisions of this bill. Any impact, however, is expected to be minimal.
