- 5. Summary: The proposed legislation would permit the parents of any public school student who has been diagnosed with diabetes to designate, in a diabetes care plan, a delegated care aide to provide diabetes care for the student, including the administration of insulin and glucagon, when a school nurse or physician is not present in the school or at a school-sponsored activity. The bill also requires the delegated care aide to receive training in diabetes care and every school employee to receive basic training in responses to emergency situations and changes from one to two the minimum number of employees in a school that must be trained with regard to a student with diabetes who attends the school. In addition, the bill includes employees of local health departments providing diabetes care to students in the list of individuals exempt from liability associated with this care.

- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** The bill requires local school divisions to put in place practices for caring for students with diabetes. It also requires local school division employees to be trained in diabetes care and all employees to be trained for diabetes emergency response. The cost of any such practices or training would be borne by the local school divisions and would not impact state finances.
