4. Title: Warning lights on certain vehicles; members of fire depts., etc., may use no more than 2 systems.

5. Summary: Provides that members of fire departments, volunteer fire companies, or volunteer rescue squads, ambulance drivers employed by a privately owned ambulance service, and police chaplains who equip a vehicle with flashing or steady-burning red or red and white combination warning lights may use no more than two "light systems" rather than two "lights."
