4. Title: Candidate filing requirements; gift disclosures.

5. Summary: Candidate filing requirements; gift disclosures. Requires candidates for Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, and the General Assembly to file gift disclosure information based on the information reportable under Schedule E of the Conflicts of Interests Acts' statement of economic interests for Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, and General Assembly members. The Schedule E information will be filed with the State Board of Elections and as part of the candidate's periodic campaign finance reports.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No state fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Board of Elections indicates that this bill would have no fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. It is likely that the submission requirements for the Secretary of the Commonwealth and the Clerks of the Senate and House of Delegates would have minimal fiscal impact.
