1.	Title:	First informer broadcaster.						

- 5. Summary: Provides that state and local governmental agencies shall grant first informer broadcasters with proper identification cards access to their broadcasting station or cable television system within any area declared a state emergency area by the Governor for the purpose of providing news, public service, and public safety information and repairing or resupplying their facility or equipment. A "first informer" is defined as critical radio, television, or cable television personnel of a radio or broadcast station or cable television system engaged in the process of broadcasting or cablecasting, the maintenance or repair of related equipment, or the transportation of fuel for generators of broadcast stations or cable systems. First informer identification cards shall be issued by the Virginia Association of Broadcasters or the Virginia Cable Television Association.

- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary; See Item 8 below.
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Virginia Department of Emergency Management, the substitute bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact.
