Summary:** The enrolled bill directs the Department of Social Services to convene a work group to review current state and federal laws and regulations governing criminal history background checks for child-care providers and to develop a plan for implementation of national fingerprint-based criminal history background checks for all child care providers in the Commonwealth. The workgroup must report its findings to the Governor and the General Assembly by November 1, 2014.
