Summary:** The proposed legislation would prohibit a member or employee of a local school board or the Department of Education (DOE) from transmitting personally identifiable information from a student's record to a federal government agency or an authorized representative of such agency, except as required by federal law or regulation.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The bill would prohibit the transfer of student information to the federal government unless required by law or regulation. The bill is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.
