4. Title: State Executive Council for Comprehensive Services for At-Risk Youth and Families; membership.

5. Summary: State Executive Council for Comprehensive Services for At-Risk Youth and Families; membership. Removes the Governor's Special Advisor on Children's Services from and adds a juvenile and domestic relations district court judge to be appointed by the Governor to the State Executive Council for Comprehensive Services for At-Risk Youth and Families. The bill clarifies technical appointment processes.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. No fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: None. This bill amends membership on the State Executive Council by replacing the appointment of a special advisor position that no longer exists with a juvenile and domestic court judge. This change will have no fiscal impact.
