**5. Summary:** The enrolled bill adds perampanel (including its salts, isomers, and salts of isomers) to the list of schedule III drugs and lorcaserin to the list of schedule IV drugs.

Fiscal Implications:** Pursuant to §30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter 806 of the 2013 Acts of Assembly requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000.
