Requires the electoral board to appoint a substitute officer of election for any election if an appointed officer of election is the spouse, parent, grandparent, child, or grandchild of a candidate in that election. Currently a candidate may request the removal of an officer of election for these grounds. The substitute holds office and serves only for that election.

8.	Fiscal Implications: The State Board of Elections indicates that this bill is not estimated to have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The amendment to this bill is technical in nature and does not change the fiscal impact estimate.
