**5. Summary:** The proposed legislation provides for the issuance of lifetime concealed handgun permits for Virginia residents. Currently, such permits must be renewed every five years.

Since the revenue from handgun permits is collected by localities and the State Police, the bill may have a negative impact on the Commonwealth's revenue and localities. The fees collected by the Department is deposited into the general fund, however, it is not possible to estimate anticipated impact on the Commonwealth's revenue as data is insufficient. According to the Department of State Police (Department), the proposal has no fiscal impact on the Department.
