3. Committee: Committee on Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: Replacement concealed handgun permits.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation provides that no fees shall be charged for the issuance of a replacement concealed handgun permit because the permit holder has changed his address (currently subject to a maximum fee of \$10) or to replace a lost or destroyed permit (currently subject to a maximum fee of \$5).

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Tentative. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of State Police (Department), the proposal has no fiscal impact on the Department.

Since the revenue from handgun permits is collected by localities and the State Police, the bill may have a negative impact on the Commonwealth's revenue and localities. The fees collected by the Department is deposited into the general fund, however, it is not possible to estimate anticipated impact on the Commonwealth's revenue as available data is insufficient.
