4. Title: Boating safety course.

5. Summary: This bill exempts persons who hold various landings and aquaculture licenses and permits from the Virginia Marine Resources Commission from the requirements of the boater safety education course. In addition, the bill also exempts individuals 45 years or older who have possessed a valid Virginia registration certificate for a motorboat for at least six continuous years from the requirements of the boater safety education course.
