**5. Summary:** Provides that a voter may be provided a paper ballot to cast his vote when, in the opinion of the chief officer of election for the precinct, the conditions at the precinct necessitate the use of paper ballots.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** None. According to the State Board of Elections, this bill is not expected to have any fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. However, it may necessitate additional paper ballots, the cost of which would be borne by localities.
