3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: School board policy; employee/student lactation support.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would require each local school board to adopt a policy to set aside, in each school in the school division, a non-restroom location that is shielded from the public view to be designated as an area in which any mother who is employed by the local school board or is enrolled in the school may take breaks of reasonable length during the school day to express milk to feed her child until the child reaches the age of one.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill would require local school divisions to take specified actions. The bill will not have a state fiscal impact. There may be costs to local school divisions to convert existing space to comply with the requirement. Any such costs cannot be determined at this time.
