4. Title: School boards; administration of student surveys and questionnaires.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would prohibit school boards from administering surveys and questionnaires requesting of students (i) sexual information, (ii) mental health information, (iii) medical information, (iv) information on student health risk behaviors, (v) information on controlled substance use, or (vi) other information that the school board deems to be sensitive in nature without written, informed parental consent for the students' participation.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill would require parental consent prior to the collection of certain information on surveys and questionnaires. The bill will not have a state fiscal impact.
