4. Title: Various boards; membership and terms.

5. Summary: Various boards; membership and terms. Reduces the number of non-legislative citizen members who serve on the Virginia Geographic Information Network Advisory Board from nine to seven by eliminating the position for an elected official who serves on a planning district commission and eliminating one of the two current representatives of a utility or transportation industry utilizing geographic data. The bill specifies that vacancies on the Litter Control and Recycling Fund Advisory Board that occur other than by expiration of term are to be filled for the unexpired term and that no person is eligible to serve on the Advisory Board for more than two terms. The engrossed bill deletes all references to the Board of Medicine and the Advisory Board on Athletic Training.
