3. Committee: Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: Dismissal of teachers and other school board employees; grounds.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would prohibit a school board employee from being dismissed or placed on probation solely on the grounds that (i) he possessed an unloaded firearm that is in a closed container in or upon his vehicle or in the locked trunk of his vehicle, a knife having a metal blade in or upon his motor vehicle, or an unloaded shotgun or rifle in a firearms rack in or upon his motor vehicle or (ii) the employee, who has a valid concealed handgun permit, possessed a concealed handgun while in his motor vehicle in a parking lot, traffic circle, or other means of vehicular ingress or egress to the school.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation would prohibit the termination of local school board employees for specified instances. The bill will have no state fiscal impact.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Local school divisions.
