**4. Title:** Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC); sale of wine and cider

**5. Summary:** Allows the sale of wine in growlers or other reusable containers that are federally approved, provided such containers are labeled in accordance with Board regulations and limited for use to persons licensed to sell wine at retail for both off and on premises consumption.

The legislation also provides for the sale of cider in any size container allowable for wine that is federally approved and labeled in accordance with Board regulations and limited for use by persons licensed to sell cider at retail for both off- and on-premise consumption.
