4. Title: Board of Education; Academic-Year Career and Technical Education Governor's School.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would require the Board of Education to develop a model proposal for establishing a joint school for career and technical education to be recommended to the Governor for designation as an Academic-Year Career and Technical Education Governor's School.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

8. Fiscal Implications: The legislation would require the Board of Education to develop a model proposal for an Academic-Year Career and Technical Education Governor's School, which may have an administrative impact on the Board. Any administrative impact can be absorbed within existing resources.
