4. Title: Special fox hunting license.

5. Summary: This bill establishes a special license for hunting foxes on horseback with hounds but without firearms. The license exempts the licensee from the requirement that he complete a hunter education program. The fee for the special license shall be the same as any license required by § 29.1-303, Code of Virginia, and shall be subject to subsequent revision by the Board pursuant to § 29.1-103, Code of Virginia. The bill also specifies that the special license shall not be required of any person holding a hunting license required by § 29.1-103.
