- **4. Title:** Biennial appropriation act.
- **5. Summary:** The bill provides that the Commonwealth's biennial appropriations shall start on July 1 of odd-numbered years beginning with the biennial appropriation act for the period July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2019. The bill requires that the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, would not be a part of any biennial appropriation act (i.e., it would be a single-year transitional budget).

- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: The transition to an odd-year biennial budget will require programming changes to the Department of Planning and Budget's statewide budget system and likely to the Department of Legislative Automated Services' budget applications. - **9.** Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: The Department of Planning and Budget; the Department of Legislative Automated Services; State agencies with internal budget applications.
