4. Title: Charitable gaming; raffles by nonprofit organizations.

5. Summary: This bill clarifies that the exemption for nonprofit organizations from the requirement to obtain a permit from the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services prior to conducting raffles that generate annual gross receipts of \$40,000 or less includes organizations granted tax-exempt status under §§ 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code.
