3. Committee: Rehabilitation and Social Services.

4. Title: State Executive Council for Comprehensive Services for At-Risk Youth and Families; membership.

5. Summary: State Executive Council for Comprehensive Services for At-Risk Youth and Families; membership. Increases the membership of the State Executive Council for Comprehensive Services for At-Risk Youth and Families by adding a third private provider representative and a member who may be either a representative of a child advocacy group or organization or a representative of a mental health advocacy group with a specialization in children's mental health. The bill also provides that the members of the Council who are parent representatives may not be a current member of a county board of supervisors or city council or a county administrator or city manager.
