| 8. | Fiscal Implications: Currently, one limited licensee is granted to an owner or operator of a steeplechase facility under § 59.1-378.1, Code of Virginia. This facility operates two days of steeplechase racing with pari-mutuel wagering. The total amount wagered from both days of live racing in 2013 was \$120,000. The addition of simulcasting the Kentucky Derby in conjunction with the steeplechase racing on the one day of operation would generate \$100,000 in additional wagering. Based on this estimate, the Virginia Racing Commission's State Racing Operations Fund would receive \$1,800 (1.8 percent), the breeders fund would |
