4. Title: Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC); limited brewery license created; local regulation of certain activities.

5. Summary: Creates a new limited brewery license and sets out the privileges of this new license. The bill also limits application of local zoning ordinances to limited brewery licensees and specifically provides that no local ordinance shall impose minimum parking, road access, or road upgrade requirements on any licensee that is licensed under § 4.1-208.
