4. **Title:** Sex Offender and Crimes against Minors Registry Act; solicitation of prostitution; minors.

5. **Summary:** The proposed legislation amends the Sex Offender and Crimes Against Minors Registry Act by adding solicitation of prostitution from a minor to a list of offenses for which registration on the registry is required. The engrossed bill provides that registration on the registry is required for any felony violation of § 18.2-346 committed on or after July 1, 2014.
