2. Patron: Norment

3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Department of Treasury; Risk Management Division; liability coverage for certain pro bono attorneys.

5. Summary: Department of Treasury; Risk Management Division; liability coverage for certain pro bono attorneys. Provides for inclusion under Treasury's local government risk management plan for attorneys providing pro bono legal services under a Virginia State Bar approved program. The bill requires the Virginia State Bar to pay the cost of coverage for eligible attorneys.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final; no state fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Virginia State Bar currently pays \$2,039 a year for the insurance coverage described in the bill. The policy grants coverage of \$250,000 per claim, \$500,000 aggregate coverage, with a \$1,000 deductible.

The Division of Risk Management (DRM) believes that it can provide coverage of \$1 million per claim, which would also be the cap amount, with a \$1,000 deductible. DRM believes that this coverage can be provided for the same amount or less than what the State Bar currently pays. DRM currently provides the same liability insurance coverage to the Virginia Supreme Court for pro bono attorneys under a program approved by the Supreme Court.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No

11. Other Comments: This bill is identical to HB712 as enrolled.
