**4. Title:** Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources.

**5. Summary:** Requires a locality that adopts a system of stormwater management service charges to provide for a waiver of at least 50 percent of such charge to any church, synagogue, or other place of worship.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary, see Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of Environmental Quality, this bill has no State fiscal impact.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** The Department of Environmental Quality, and localities.

**10. Technical Amendment Necessary:** No.

**11. Other Comments:** Localities that have stormwater service charges may collect less revenue from service charges. However, the localities will still have authority to impose stormwater permit fees to cover their costs associated with the Virginia Stormwater Management Program regulations.
