3. Committee: Education

4. Title: College partnership laboratory schools; tuition.

5. Summary: Currently, the Code of Virginia prohibits college partnership laboratory schools from charging tuition for courses required for high school graduation. The Code allows the schools to charge tuition for courses for which the student receives college credit and for enrichment courses that are not required to earn a Board of Education approved high school diploma.

The proposed legislation would authorize the school board of a school division that partners with a college partnership laboratory school to charge tuition to students enrolled in the college partnership laboratory school who do not reside within the partnering division.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill would require students to pay tuition to attend college partnership laboratory schools if they do not reside in the partnering school district. The bill will not impact state finances.
