**3. Committee:** Passed Both Houses

**4. Title:** Concealed handgun permits; records.

**5. Summary:** Provides that any references to the issuance of a concealed handgun permit before July 1, 2008, in any order book by a circuit court clerk are exempt from the requirement that such orders be withheld from public disclosure. The bill also directs circuit court clerks to issue replacement permits to permit holders who undergo a lawful name change.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Office of the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court (OES), the provisions of this legislation would likely require changes to the electronic records management systems utilized by the courts.
