4. Title: Electric utilities; costs of offshore wind facilities.

5. Summary: Electric utilities; costs of offshore wind facilities. Limits the portion of the costs incurred by an investor-owned electric utility between July 1, 2007, and December 31, 2013, in developing offshore wind facilities that are recoverable through a rate adjustment clause to 30 % of such amount. The remaining 70% of such costs may be recovered through existing base rates as determined by the State Corporation Commission in the test periods under review in the utility's next biennial review filed after July 1, 2014. All of the costs incurred after December 31, 2013, may be deferred for recovery through a rate adjustment clause as may be approved by the State Corporation Commission. The measure also states that the planning and development activities for new generation facilities utilizing energy derived from offshore wind are in the public interest.
