4. Title: Office of the Attorney General; employment of outside counsel where a conflict of interests exists.

5. Summary: Requires the Attorney General's office to enter into an agreement with outside counsel to provide legal services in a matter when the Attorney General certifies to the Governor that it would be improper for his office to do so because a conflict of interests exists. The compensation for the legal services provided shall be based upon a reasonable per hour fee and shall be expended from funds appropriated to the Attorney General's office.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would require the cost for outside counsel services to be expended from funds appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General. Currently, these costs are paid by the agency requiring the legal services and not the Office of the Attorney General. The number of situations in the future where there is deemed to be a need to utilize outside counsel is not known. In the past year, invoices for these legal services have totaled approximately \$800,000. However, the extent to which this level of utilization will continue is not fully known.
