**4. Title:** Department of Criminal Justice Services; human trafficking policy.

**5. Summary:** The substitute requires the Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) publish and disseminate a model policy or guideline for law enforcement personnel involved in criminal investigations or assigned to vehicle or street patrol duties to ensure that law enforcement personnel are sensitive to and aware of human trafficking offenses and the identification of victims of human trafficking offenses.
