3. Committee: Health, Welfare and Institutions

4. Title: Board for Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators and Onsite Sewage System Professionals.

5. Summary: Provides that the Board for Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators and Onsite Sewage System Professionals will extend one time and deem to be valid an interim license for an alternative onsite sewage system installer issued in accordance with regulations of the Board to any person who holds a valid interim license at such time they apply to take the examination required for issuance of an alternative onsite sewage system installer license. An interim license renewed in accordance with the provisions of this bill will be valid until as the licensee receives a passing score on the examination required for issuance of a license or for a period of six months, whichever occurs sooner. The bill contains an emergency clause.
