10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 17.1-279.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 17.1-279.1. Additional assessment for electronic summons system.
13	Any county or city, through its governing body, may assess an additional sum not in excess of \$5 as
14	part of the costs in each criminal or traffic case in the district or circuit courts located within its
15	boundaries where such cases arising in such county or city are brought in which the defendant is
16	charged with a violation of any statute or ordinance. The imposition of such assessment shall be by
17	ordinance of the governing body, which may provide for different sums in circuit courts and district
18	courts. The assessment shall be collected by the clerk of the court in which the action is filed, remitted
19	to the treasurer of the appropriate county or city, and held by such treasurer subject to disbursements by

the governing body to a local law-enforcement agency solely to fund software, hardware, and associated
equipment costs for the implementation and maintenance of an electronic summons system.
