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VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact §§ 2.2-1605 and 2.2-4310 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Virginia 3 Public Procurement Act; small, women-owned, and minority-owned businesses.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That §§ 2.2-1605 and 2.2-4310 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 8 § 2.2-1605. Powers and duties of Department. 9

A. The Department shall have the following powers and duties:

10 1. Coordinate as consistent with prevailing law the plans, programs, and operations of the state government that affect or may contribute to the establishment, preservation, and strengthening of small, 11 12 women-owned, and minority-owned businesses;

2. Promote the mobilization of activities and resources of state and local governments, businesses and 13 trade associations, universities, foundations, professional organizations, and volunteer and other groups 14 15 towards the growth of small businesses and businesses owned by women and minorities, and facilitate the coordination of the efforts of these groups with those of state departments and agencies; 16

3. Establish a center for the development, collection, summarization, and dissemination of 17 18 information that will be helpful to persons and organizations throughout the nation in undertaking or 19 promoting procurement from small, women-owned, and minority-owned businesses;

20 4. Consistent with prevailing law and availability of funds, and according to the Director's discretion, 21 provide technical and management assistance to small, women-owned, and minority-owned businesses 22 and defray all or part of the costs of pilot or demonstration projects that are designed to overcome the 23 special problems of small, women-owned, and minority-owned businesses;

24 5. Manage the Capital Access Fund for Disadvantaged Businesses created pursuant to § 2.2-2311 and, 25 in cooperation with the Small Business Financing Authority, determine the qualifications, terms, and 26 conditions for the use of such Fund; and

27 6. Implement any remediation or enhancement measure for small, women-owned, or minority-owned 28 businesses as may be authorized by the Governor pursuant to subsection C of § 2.2-4310 and develop 29 regulations, consistent with prevailing law, for program implementation. Such regulations shall be 30 developed in consultation with the state agencies with procurement responsibility and promulgated by 31 those agencies in accordance with applicable law; and

32 7. Receive and coordinate, with the appropriate state agency, the investigation of complaints that a business certified pursuant to this chapter has failed to comply with its subcontracting plan under 33 subsection D of § 2.2-4310. If the Department determines that a business certified pursuant to this 34 35 chapter has failed to comply with the subcontracting plan, the business shall provide a written 36 *explanation*.

37 B. In addition, the Department shall serve as the liaison between the Commonwealth's existing 38 businesses and state government in order to promote the development of Virginia's economy. To that 39 end, the Department shall:

40 1. Encourage the training or retraining of individuals for specific employment opportunities at new or 41 expanding business facilities in the Commonwealth;

42 2. Develop and implement programs to assist small businesses in the Commonwealth in order to 43 promote their growth and the creation and retention of jobs for Virginians;

44 3. Establish an industry program that is the principal point of communication between basic 45 employers in the Commonwealth and the state government that will address issues of significance to 46 business;

47 4. Make available to existing businesses, in conjunction and cooperation with localities, chambers of **48** commerce, and other public and private groups, basic information and pertinent factors of interest and 49 concern to such businesses;

50 5. Develop statistical reports on job creation and the general economic conditions in the 51 Commonwealth; and

6. Administer the Small Business Jobs Grant Fund Program and the Small Business Investment Grant 52 53 Fund described in Article 2 (§ 2.2-1611 et seq.).

54 C. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall assist the Department upon request and furnish such 55 information and assistance as the Department may require in the discharge of its duties.

56 § 2.2-4310. Discrimination prohibited; participation of small, women-owned, minority-owned,

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57 and service disabled veteran-owned business.

A. In the solicitation or awarding of contracts, no public body shall discriminate against a bidder or 58 59 offeror because of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, disability, status as a service disabled 60 veteran, or any other basis prohibited by state law relating to discrimination in employment. Whenever 61 solicitations are made, each public body shall include businesses selected from a list made available by 62 the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity.

B. All public bodies shall establish programs consistent with this chapter to facilitate the participation 63 of small businesses and businesses owned by women, minorities, and service disabled veterans in 64 procurement transactions. The programs established shall be in writing and shall comply with the 65 66 provisions of any enhancement or remedial measures authorized by the Governor pursuant to subsection 67 C or, where applicable, by the chief executive of a local governing body pursuant to § 15.2-965.1, and shall include specific plans to achieve any goals established therein. State agencies shall submit annual 68 progress reports on small, women-owned, and minority-owned business procurement and on service disabled veteran-owned business procurement to the Department of Small Business and Supplier 69 70 Diversity in a form specified by the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity. The Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity shall make information on service disabled 71 72 73 veteran-owned procurement available to the Department of Veterans Services upon request.

74 C. Whenever there exists (i) a rational basis for small business enhancement or (ii) a persuasive 75 analysis that documents a statistically significant disparity between the availability and utilization of 76 women-owned and minority-owned businesses, the Governor is authorized and encouraged to require 77 state agencies to implement appropriate enhancement or remedial measures consistent with prevailing 78 law.

79 D. In awarding a contract for services to a small, women-owned, or minority-owned business that is 80 certified in accordance with § 2.2-1606, or to a business identified by a public body as a service disabled veteran-owned business where the award is being made pursuant to an enhancement or 81 remedial program as provided in subsection C, the public body shall include in every such contract of 82 83 more than \$10,000 the following:

84 "If the contractor intends to subcontract work as part of its performance under this contract, the 85 contractor shall include in the proposal a plan to subcontract to small, women-owned, minority-owned, and service disabled veteran-owned businesses." 86

87 E. In the solicitation or awarding of contracts, no state agency, department or institution shall 88 discriminate against a bidder or offeror because the bidder or offeror employs ex-offenders unless the 89 state agency, department or institution has made a written determination that employing ex-offenders on 90 the specific contract is not in its best interest. 91

 $\overline{\mathbf{E}}$. F. As used in this section:

"Minority individual" means an individual who is a citizen of the United States or a legal resident 92 93 alien and who satisfies one or more of the following definitions:

94 1. "African American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part. 95

96 2. "Asian American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, 97 Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands, including but not limited to Japan, China, 98 Vietnam, Samoa, Laos, Cambodia, Taiwan, Northern Mariana Islands, the Philippines, a U.S. territory of 99 the Pacific, India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, or Sri Lanka and who is regarded as such by the community of 100 which this person claims to be a part.

101 3. "Hispanic American" means a person having origins in any of the Spanish-speaking peoples of 102 Mexico, South or Central America, or the Caribbean Islands or other Spanish or Portuguese cultures and 103 who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part.

104 4. "Native American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America 105 and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part or who is 106 recognized by a tribal organization.

"Minority-owned business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, 107 108 109 partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership 110 interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and 111 112 daily business operations are controlled by one or more minority individuals.

"Service disabled veteran" means a veteran who (i) served on active duty in the United States 113 114 military ground, naval, or air service, (ii) was discharged or released under conditions other than 115 dishonorable, and (iii) has a service-connected disability rating fixed by the United States Department of 116 Veterans Affairs.

"Service disabled veteran business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or 117

118 more service disabled veterans or, in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company

119 or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership interest in the corporation, partnership, or 120 limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or more individuals who are service disabled

121 veterans and both the management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more 122 individuals who are service disabled veterans.

"Small business" means a business, independently owned and controlled by one or more individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and together with affiliates, has 250 or fewer employees, or annual gross receipts of \$10 million or less averaged over the previous three years. One or more of the individual owners shall control both the management and daily business operations of the small business.

128 "State agency" means any authority, board, department, instrumentality, institution, agency, or other
129 unit of state government. "State agency" shall not include any county, city, or town.
130 "Women-owned business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more women

130 "Women-owned business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more women 131 who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited 132 liability company or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership interest is owned by one or 133 more women who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and daily business 134 operations are controlled by one or more women.
