For the purpose of this section, "starter interrupt device" means a piece of electronic equipment 15 installed in a motor vehicle that, when activated, prevents the vehicle from starting. B. No person other than the title owner of the vehicle shall install or cause to be installed, on any 16 motor vehicle other than a commercial motor vehicle as defined in § 46.2-341.4, any starter interrupt 17 device. Furthermore, no person shall require the installation of a starter interruptor device as a 18

starter interrupt device on any noncommercial motor vehicle is void.

C. Any person convicted of a violation of this section shall be liable to the owner of the motor vehicle for the cost of removal of the starter interrupt device and restoration of the vehicle's ignition system to good working order, statutory damages of \$1,000, reasonable attorney's fees, and court costs in any civil action brought pursuant to this section.
