6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 34-26 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by
7	adding in Chapter 3 of Title 34 a section numbered 34-28.2, relating to bankruptcy proceeding
8	exemptions.
9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 34-26 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is
11	amended by adding in Chapter 3 of Title 34 a section numbered 34-28.2 as follows:
12	§ 34-26. Poor debtor's exemption; exempt articles enumerated.
13	In addition to the exemptions provided in Chapter 2 (§ 34-4 et seq.), every householder shall be
14	entitled to hold exempt from creditor process the following enumerated items:
15	1. The family Bible.
16	1a. Wedding and engagement rings.
17	2. Family portraits and family heirlooms not to exceed \$5,000 in value.
18	3. (i) A lot in a burial ground, and (ii) any preneed funeral contract not to exceed \$5,000.
19 20	4. All wearing apparel of the householder not to exceed \$1,000 in value.
20 21	4a. All household furnishings including, but not limited to, beds, dressers, floor coverings, stoves, refrigerators, washing machines, dryers, sewing machines, pots and pans for cooking, plates, and eating
22	utensils, not to exceed \$5,000 in value.
23	4b. One firearm Firearms, not to exceed a total of \$3,000 in value.
24	5. All animals owned as pets, such as cats, dogs, birds, squirrels, rabbits and other pets not kept or
25	raised for sale or profit.
26	6. Medically prescribed health aids.
27	7. Tools, books, instruments, implements, equipment, and machines, including motor vehicles,
28 29	vessels, and aircraft, which are necessary for use in the course of the householder's occupation or trade not exceeding \$10,000 in value, except that a perfected security interest on such personal property shall
30	have priority over the claim of exemption under this section. A motor vehicle, vessel or aircraft used to
31	commute to and from a place of occupation or trade and not otherwise necessary for use in the course
32	of such occupation or trade shall not be exempt under this subdivision. "Occupation," as used in this
33	subdivision, includes enrollment in any public or private elementary, secondary, or career and technical
34	education school or institution of higher education.
35	8. A motor vehicle Motor vehicles, not held as exempt under subdivision 7, owned by the householder not to avoid a total of 6000 in value avoid that a perfected sequrity interact on the a
36 37	householder, not to exceed a total of \$6,000 in value, except that a perfected security interest on the a motor vehicle shall have priority over the claim of exemption under this subdivision.
38	9. Those portions of a tax refund or governmental payment attributable to the Child Tax Credit or
39	Additional Child Tax Credit pursuant to § 24 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the
40	Earned Income Credit pursuant to § 32 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
41	10. Unpaid spousal or child support.
42	The value of an item claimed as exempt under this section shall be the fair market value of the item
43 44	less any prior security interest. The monetary limits, where provided, are applicable to the total value of property claimed as exempt
44	under that subdivision.
46	The purchase of an item claimed as exempt under this section with nonexempt property in
47	contemplation of bankruptcy or creditor process shall not be deemed to be in fraud of creditors.
48	No officer or other person shall levy or distrain upon, or attach, such articles, or otherwise seek to
49	subject such articles to any lien or process. It shall not be required that a householder designate any
50	property exempt under this section in a deed in order to secure such exemption.
51 52	§ 34-28.2. Spousal and child support exempt. The debtor's right to receive spousal or child support, to the extent reasonably necessary for the
