| 12 | WHEREAS, the Founders of the United States Constitution empowered state legislators to be |
| 13 | guardians of liberty against excessive use of power by the federal government; and |
| 14 | WHEREAS, the federal government has created a mounting national debt exceeding \$17 trillion |
| 15 | through improper and imprudent spending; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, the federal government has usurped the legitimate roles of the states through unfunded |
| 17 | federal mandates; and |
| 18 | WHEREAS, the federal government has ceased to operate under a proper interpretation of the Tenth |
| 19 | Amendment to the United States Constitution; and |
| 20 | WHEREAS, it is the solemn duty of the states to protect the liberty of our people, particularly for |
| 21 22 | the generations to come, by proposing amendments to the United States Constitution through a convention of the states under Article V to place clear restricted on these and related excessive uses of |

| 23 24 | RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly of the |
| 25 | Commonwealth of Virginia hereby make application to the Congress of the United States to call an |
| 26 | amendment convention of the states pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution limited to |
| 27 | proposing amendments to the United States Constitution that impose fiscal restraints on the federal |
| 28 | government, limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and limit the terms of office for |
| 29 | its officials and for members of Congress; and, be it |
| 30 | RESOLVED FURTHER, That the other states be encouraged to make similar applications for an |
| 31 | amendment convention pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution; and, be it |
| 32 | RESOLVED FURTHER, That this application shall constitute a continuing application for such |
| 33 | amendment convention pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution until the legislatures of |
| 34 | two-thirds of the states have made applications on the same subject and such convention has been called |
| 35 | by the Congress of the United States; and, be it |
| 36 | RESOLVED FINALLY, That Clerk of the House of Delegates transmit copies of this resolution to |
| 37 | the President of the United States, the Speaker and the Clerk of the United States House of |
| 38 | Representatives, the President and the Clerk of the United States Senate, the members of the Virginia |
| 39 | Congressional Delegation, and the legislatures of each of the several states, attesting the adoption of this |
| 40 | resolution by the General Assembly of Virginia. |
